Patient Consent for Use and Disclosure of Protected Health Information

PIEDMONT HEALTHCARE FOR WOMEN, CENTRAL CAROLINA OB/GYN DIVISION'S Notice of Privacy Practices provides a more complete description of such uses and disclosures. The patient has the right to review the Notice of Privacy prior to signing this consent. PIEDMONT HEALTHCARE FOR WOMEN, CENTRAL CAROLINA OB/GYN DIVISION reserves the right to revise its Notice of Privacy Practices at anytime. PIEDMONT HEALTHCARE FOR WOMEN, CENTRAL CAROLINA OB/GYN DIVISION may call my home or other alternative location and leave a message on voice mail or in person in reference to any item and any calls pertaining to my clinical care, including laboratory results among others.

PIEDMONT HEALTHCARE FOR WOMEN, CENTRAL CAROLINA OB/GYN DIVISION may mail to my home or other alternative location any items that assist the practice in carrying out TPO, such as appointment reminder cards and patient statements as long as they are marked "Personal and Confidential".

PIEDMONT HEALTHCARE FOR WOMEN, CENTRAL CAROLINA OB/GYN DIVISION may email to my home or other alternative location any items that assist the practice in carrying out TPO, such as appointment reminder cards and patient statements. I have the right to request that PIEDMONT HEALTHCARE FOR WOMEN, CENTRAL CAROLINA OB/GYN DIVISION restrict how it uses or discloses my PHI to carry out TPO. However, the practice is not required to agree to my requested restrictions, but if it does, it is bound by this agreement.

The patient may revoke consent in writing except to the extent that the practice has already made disclosure in reliance upon prior consent. If patient does not sign the consent, or later revoke it, PIEDMONT HEALTHCARE FOR WOMEN may decline to provide treatment.
